File 1: Data set 1 (spss file): raw data collected via original anonymised questionnaire (2017) from 297 participants:

Far left hand corner = each individual participant listed from 1 - 297 SEX = Female or Male (1 = male; 2 = female)

Nationality stated as follows:

- 1 = British
- 2 = North American
- 3 = Australasian
- 4 = Other European
- 5 = Other
- 6 = Prefer not to say

SBQ = Total score for the individual participant for the Survival Beliefs Questionnaire (new measure designed by Northumbria University as per this current study)

RAPI_Theism = Score for the individual for the Theism sub-scale of the Religious Attitudes and Practices Inventory *

RAPI_Spirit = Score the individual for the Spirituality sub-scale of Religious Attitudes and Practices Inventory

RAPI_tot = Total score for the individual for the Religious Attitudes and Practices Inventory

RPBS_rel = Score for the individual for the Traditional Religious Belief subscale of The Revised Paranormal Belief Scale**

RPBS_psi = Score for the individual for the PSI subscale of The Revised Paranormal Belief Scale

RPBS_witch = Score for the individual for the Witchcraft subscale of The Revised Paranormal Belief Scale

RPBS_super = Score for the individual for the Superstition subscale of The Revised Paranormal Belief Scale

RPBS_spirit = Score for the individual for the Spiritualism subscale of The Revised Paranormal Belief Scale

Far left hand corner = individual participant number

Columns B-S = refer to the score for the numbered individual for each of the 18 items of the SBQ

Column T = refers the total SBQ score for the numbered individual

File 3: Data set 3 (excel file) for **retest** of test-retest measure for Survival Beliefs Questionnaire (SBQ). Data collected for 20 participants April – September 2017 (participants 1-20), and a further 10 participants July-September 2018 (participants 21-30)

Far left hand corner = individual participant number (same as test)

Columns B-S = refer to the score for the numbered individual for each of the 18 items of the SBQ

Column T = refers the total SBQ score for the numbered individual

NB= All scores for item number 16 reversed for both test and retest
